



2019 USASA National Championships – Junior Nationals Quota Allocation

Halfpipe Open Class – Must have USASA and FIS competitor license to compete

1. Top 20 athletes per gender (not already qualified through USASA criteria) will qualify from the 4th U.S. Ski & Snowboard Freeski Halfpipe points list.*

Slopestyle Open Class – Must have USASA and FIS competitor license to compete

 Top 20 athletes per gender (not already qualified through USASA criteria) will qualify from the 4th U.S. Ski & Snowboard Freeski Slopestyle points list.*

Please note:

- Athletes that qualify in Open Class must compete in Open Class for every discipline. If an athlete
 wants to compete in their age group at USASA National Championships they must qualify
 through a regional qualifying series in their respective age group.
- U.S. Ski and Snowboard Junior National Championship age group awards will not be given out in addition to USASA National Championship awards for Slopestyle and Halfpipe.
- To participate in these FIS sanctioned event athletes must be born in 2005 or later.

2019 U.S. Ski & Snowboard Junior Nationals Big Air Qualification Criteria

Big Air – Must have a USASA, FIS and U.S. Ski and Snowboard competitor license to compete

- 1. Top (age eligible) twenty (20) men and ten (10) women will qualify using their two (2) best U.S. Ski & Snowboard sanctioned event results summed and divided by 2. **Note**: to qualify an athlete must have one (1) Big Air result and one (1) Slopestyle result.*
- 2. Top age eligible athletes from the following groups will qualify from the 2018 USASA National Championships Slopestyle results: ten (10) men and five (5) women from the Youth age group, ten (10) men and five (5) women from the Junior age group, and ten (10) men and five (5) women from Open Class.*
- 3. Top (age eligible) twenty (20) men and ten (10) women from the overall 2019 Revolution Elite Tour Slopestyle results will qualify.*
- 4. Top (age eligible) ten (10) men and top five (5) women from the overall 2019 Revolution Tour Slopestyle results will qualify.*

Please note:

- Age eligible athletes for the 2019 Junior National Championship Big Air must be born between 2000 and 2005.
- To participate in these FIS sanctioned event athletes must be born in 2005 or later.
- In the Big Air event the overall top 3 finishers per gender will be recognized as well as the top (1) finisher per gender in U15, U17 and U19.

*If athletes are qualified through another criteria spots may be passed down the respective list until the quota is fulfilled.
