

U.S. Ski & Snowboard Tuition Reimbursement

U.S. Ski & Snowboard will reimburse athletes up to \$6,000 annually for college courses taken within the previous academic year (fall-summer terms) from any college. Reimbursement occurs twice annually, 1) in the fall (October-November) for courses taken the previous spring / summer terms and 2) in the spring (May-June) for courses taken the previous fall / winter terms.

Schedule

- Reimbursement is available 2x annually (schedule below)
- Required registration fees and course textbooks can be included
- The next tuition reimbursement period will start April 15, 2019.

Term (courses taken during this time period)	Submission Period	Anticipated Reimbursement Date
Fall 2018 – Winter 2018/2019	April 15 - June 1, 2019	June 30, 2019
Spring 2019 – Summer 2019	October 1 -November 1, 2019	December, 2019
Fall 2019 – Winter 2010/2020	April 15 - June 1, 2020	June 30, 2020
Spring 2020– Summer 2020	October 1 -November 1, 2020	December, 2020

Students must complete an online application (Google Form application form) and/or submit the following documents directly to Julie Glusker – julie.glusker@usskiandsnowboard.org

- Copies of grades or transcripts to prove course completion C or better
- Copies of invoices detailing tuition, required registration fees, and book expenses
- Copies of receipts proving payment of tuition, registration fees, and books

Athletes who take college courses during their time on national teams can earn up to 4 years of tuition reimbursement via 1:1 / course:tuition earned annually (up to 4 years) *

- 1 year on team with 1 college course = 1 year tuition reimbursement
- 2 years on team with 1 college course = 2 years tuition reimbursement
- 3 years on team with 1 college course = 3 years tuition reimbursement
- 4 years tuition reimbursement with college course = 4 years tuition reimbursement.

Athletes who do not taken any college courses during their time on national teams will still be eligible for 2 years of tuition reimbursement in the 2 years following their retirement.
