<b>Level 2 - National Level</b>		
Assigned as TD, TDA, or Jury member for a NRL Competition, or as TDA or Jury Member for a FIS competition.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Maintain U.S. Ski &amp; Snowboard Officials Membership.</li> <li>2. Serve as Level 1 for minimum of 2 years including assignments as TDA or Jury Member for at least 6 competition days.</li> <li>3. Recommendation for advancement by the Regional Coordinator.</li> <li>4. Two successful evaluations by Level 2 or Level 3 TD.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Attend regional seminar every two years.</li> <li>2. Available to accept two jury assignments each season</li> <li>3. Available to provide service to the cross-county officials community; present at seminars, organize seminars, serve as Chief of Competition, serve on committee or working group.</li> </ol>
<b>Level 3 – FIS TD</b>		
Assigned as TD, TDA, or Jury Member for a NRL or FIS competition.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Maintain U.S. Ski &amp; Snowboard Officials Membership.</li> <li>5. Serve as Level 2 for minimum of 2 years including assignments as TD, TDA, or Jury Member for at least 6 competition days.</li> <li>2. Recommended as an outstanding candidate by a review committee comprised of the U.S. Ski &amp; Snowboard Regional Coordinators and the FIS National TD Coordinator.</li> <li>3. Follow the process outlined in the FIS GOETD, with minimum assignment of 6 competition days over the evaluation period. One of the Part A assessments must be from an assignment as jury member at a multi-day, Championship event.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Attend FIS seminar every two years.</li> <li>2. Accept two or more TD assignments each season.</li> <li>3. Available to provide service to the cross-county officials community; present at seminars, organize seminars, serve as Chief of Competition, serve on committee or working group.</li> </ol>
<b>Fast Track</b>		
Candidates who have current experience as a coach or team leader at national level events (USA Nationals, Junior Nationals, and or SuperTour), or who are a Chief of Competition at national level events may be considered for fast-tracked advancement to become a Level 3 Candidate. Eligible candidates are still required to pass the Level 1 written exam.
