# Request for Cross Country Course Homologation

## **Deadline**

Applications should be received before U.S. Ski and Snowboard Annual Congress. Applications received after August 15 are not guaranteed to be processed for the subsequent competition season. Normally, all inspections should be completed and Inspector's reports submitted to FIS by October 30.

#### **Fees**

Application Fee \$150, paid to U.S SKi and Snowboard, this amount will be applied to the cost of the FIS Certificates. FIS fees include 100 Swiss Francs application fee and 125 Swiss Francs per course. The FIS fees will be billed from U.S. Ski and Snowboard upon issuing of the certificates. The expenses of the Homologation Inspector are separate from the Application Fee and the Certificate Fees, these are paid directly to the Inspector.

## **Homologation Procedure**

- 1. Submit Application for Homologation
- 2. An Inspector is nominated to FIS by the Working Group for Homologation.
- 3. Inspector contacts the applicant to arrange for acquiring the technical data and the inspection.
- 4. Inspection and evaluation per the FIS Homologation Manual.
- 5. Approval of the Homologation Report by the FIS.
- 6. Issuing of the certificates.

### **Duration of Certificates**

Venue

The FIS Homologation Certificates are issued for a period of five years. If there are significant changes to the course, or negative remarks from a Technical Delegate, or no FIS competitions held on the course over the period of the certificate, the course may be subject to re-homologation. If not, the certificate will be administratively renewed for five more years.
