USA Team Selection Criteria and Procedure

Eligibility

Participants must:

- Only the athletes who satisfy the following conditions may take part in a FISU sporting event:
 - o a. be a national of the country they represent
 - b. be at least 18 and no **older than 25 years of age** on 31 December of the year of the event (ie born between 1 January 1996 and 31 December 2003)
- Be a student who is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at the university or similar institute.
 - Or, be a former student of the institutions mentioned above who have obtained their academic degree or diploma in the calendar year, 2020, preceding the event.
- Be registered with a current USA FIS license
- Be current Alpine Competitor member of USSA
- Be ranked in the top 500 on the 1st FIS List in one event, SL, GS, SG.
- Be ranked in the top 100 of USA skiers on the 1st FIS list in one event, SL, GS, SG and must commit to competing in at least 2 of the SL, GS, SG events
- Arrive on site Dec 10 and depart by Dec 22

Dates and Deadlines

July 1, Intent registration deadline on USSS Intent site

July 16, Confirmation of intent with \$1,000 deposit due on USSS Event Registration site September 15, Selections are final and balance payment due.

Team Size, Start Rights and Selection

Team size will be 8 men and 8 women.

The team selection list will be by NTSM of SL, GS, SG from the 1st 2022 FIS list. Alternates will be listed.

Only 6 men and 6 women may take part in the same event, SL, GS, SG, Individual Parallel.

The Team Event will consist of 2 men and 2 women.

All team members will have at least 2 starts in SL, GS, SG.

Start rights in SL, GS, SG will be assigned by current FIS rank in each event while assuring that all team members get at least 2 starts.

Individual Parallel and Team Parallel starts will be assigned by the coaching staff.
