#### 9. Selection Criteria

### **World University Games Selection Criteria**

- o World University Games will be hosted in Lake Placid, NY in 2023
- Noted that there are required sports and optional sports due to hosting location facilities
  - SJ/NC are optional sports
  - Lake Placid has decided to include them in the events for 2023
  - SJ/NC will not be included in 2025
- Overview of Bryan Fish's criteria for Cross Country
  - Generic to FIS regulations
  - Eligible being a university student
- Cross Country has their commitment by October 15<sup>th</sup> early timeline
  - Lake Placid is working on contract contract is dictating date Lake Placid would like to change that if they can
  - Would like to have deadline be end of October National Championships, other events as qualifiers that we could include
  - Qualification period is still TBD
- o Criteria:
  - Unable to find SJ/NC quota guidelines
    - CX is allowed 8 competitors 6 take part in individual and 4 in the relay

- Jed will check on quotas
- SJ selection based on World Ranking list, WC points, COC points, FIS points, then US Cup
- NC selection would be same as SJ omitting FIS points
- Lenient on full-time student
- o Dates are good for SJ/NC participation

# Junior World Championship Criteria

- o Criteria will go back to what we had 2 years ago
  - Due to COVID last year's criteria was altered
- Date of JWSC: Feb 27<sup>th</sup>-March 6<sup>th</sup>
- o Qualification period: November 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021-January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022
  - Event is later this year, thus the extended qualification period
  - No objections to extended qualification period
  - Tentative qualifiers: #1 Steamboat Springs, CO, #2 Lake Placid, NY, #3 Eau Claire, WI
  - Selection in order of WC points, COC points, Junior World Qualifiers
  - NC selection for JWSC qualifiers will be points back
  - SJ selection for JWSC qualifiers will be cumulative points for all 3 competitions
- o Athletes must declare their sport by November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021
- o Race lengths for JWSC qualifiers TBD for venue approval
  - Length of race based on location/quota
    - Men: 2, 10km & 1, 5km race OR 3, 10km races
    - Women: 3, 5km races
    - Venues can decide between themselves to determine who will host which length
- o WUG as tie-breakers for both NC and SJ this received the coaches approval
- o Criteria lives on USANS website under "teams", then "criteria"

  - Have used this format for 3 years Paul officially putting rules in the guidebook

- o Paul will bring to Officials Sport Committee
- o Alissa Johnson, Jessica Jerome, and Linsey Van have been nominated to be added as TDs in accelerated program through FIS

- Working to develop annual rules review testing program
- o Continue to work towards FIS licensing for COC that oversee FIS level events
- Discussion for officials committee to look at rules and come up with a suggestion for term limit for FIS Obman role – Paul agreed to bring that to the subcommittee
