

Event VS Competition



- Event
 - An event is a sequence of competitions, i.e., races, that are all under the same organizing committee and officials team.
 - An event can cover multiple days with multiple competitions, but must all be the same scoring level and same sport.
 - National Championships are 1 event with multiple competitions over multiple days.
 - You should not create multiple schedule agreements for each separate competition.

Competition

- A competition is a single scoring race, run or jump per gender and date.
- Example: Alpine: 2 Competitions, Men GS on Saturday and Women GS on Saturday.
- Example: XC: Men Mass Start for U18 and older.
- Example: FRE: Women Aerials on Saturday
- Example: BRD: Men Half Pipe

To Start



- Go to my.usskiandsnowboard.org and login with Club credentials
 - If you have been logged in with your personal credentials, then you must logout and login with the club credentials
 - Make sure you login says "Welcome <Club Name>






Previous Season Events





Click this box ONLY if using the U.S. Ski & Snowboard online athlete registration. If it is checked, then the remaining information must be entered.

Open Date – First day athletes can register. Opens at midnight.

Close Date – Last date registration is open with or without late fee. Registration closes at midnight at the end of the date entered. If you are using a late fee, this date must be after the late fee starts.


Late Fee Start Date – Late Fee starts at midnight of the beginning of the date entered.

Late Fee – Amount added to each Competition Fee. If you have linked competitions, it is only added to the overall fee.

Competition – Discipline as defined per sport

Classes – Classes are available based on scoring type. To select more than 1 class, click the top and then <Ctrl><Click> the bottom class

Lift Fee – this is just general information and is not displayed to the public.

Trail – Valid Homologation will be displayed if needed by sport.




Editing Events
