The 2022-23 season was one for the record books across all our sport disciplines. From Mikaela Shiffrin's world record-shattering performance to Jessie Diggins' historic World Cup win, from never-before-seen tricks to crowned National Champions and Nations Cup winners, we are incredibly proud of our team and what they have accomplished.

## ORGANIZATION



### Who we are, what we do, and why it matters

U.S. Ski & Snowboard is an Olympic sports organization dedicated to helping young skiers and snowboarders become world-class competitors.

We have a broad mandate not only to provide the best possible training and coaching, but also to remove as many obstacles as possible on the path towards athletic success for the 180 athletes on the national team in the 2022-23 season.

U.S. Ski & Snowboard is the National Governing Body (NGB) for the seven ski and snowboard sports – **alpine, cross country, freeski, freestyle, nordic combined, ski jumping, and snowboard.**

NGBs are independent federations that govern specific sports through common consent within the sport and are accountable to the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC). We are the nation's largest winter sports NGB, encompassing a wide variety of sport programs designed to develop athletes to participate at the highest levels of international competition and represent the United States of America. In order to develop and achieve athletic success, U.S. Ski & Snowboard provides a development pipeline, criteria, and a support system for athletes, coaches and officials.

The national team athletes train and compete to be

the best in world, often at significant personal risk. They forego traditional pathways to success for a chance to become the greatest in their sports, which is physically challenging and holds no certainty of success. And unlike their international competitors who benefit from the financial security of government-sponsored programs, our athletes rely solely on the generosity of individual donors, foundations and corporate sponsorships to fund their sports careers.

### U.S. athletes do not receive any government funding

The U.S. Ski & Snowboard Foundation raises funds from individuals and foundations to provide continuous, direct support for the national team athletes, including their training camps, coaching, competition fees, travel expenses, and sports medicine and nutritional needs.

We pursue growth for the organization through a long-term strategic plan that values the achievements of the individual athlete and the team as our defining measurement of success. To attain our ambitious goal of being the best in the world across all our disciplines, we are striving to provide our athletes with the mental, physical and financial tools they need to achieve competitive success.

# An American Phenomenon

At just 27 years old and 12 years to the day after her first race on the World Cup, Mikaela Shiffrin became the greatest alpine skier of all time with her 87th win. Disciplined, focused and always humble, Mikaela now inhabits the rarefied world of sports legends whose accomplishments and accolades will be chased by future generations. The numbers can be overwhelming when you break all records but as Mikaela reminds us, all it takes to get there is a few good turns.

# The Will To Win

**Jessie Diggins.** She's been skiing since she was four years old and competing since she was 11, but her name didn't become mainstream until 2018 when she and Kikkan Randall won the first-ever Olympic gold medal for the United States in the cross country team sprint. Since then, Jessie's power has only continued to grow. At the 2022 Winter Olympics, she won the silver medal in the 30 kilometer freestyle and the bronze medal in the individual sprint, and with her recent World Cup win, she has become **the most decorated American cross country skier of all time.**

Known for her dynamic and strategic racing style, Jessie's storied career has been building to this moment for a long time. Between 2013 and 2017, Jessie won four medals at the FIS Nordic World Ski Championships and would later become the first American to win a gold medal at the event for an individual contest in 2023. In 2021, she clinched the top spot in the women's overall standings for the 2020-21 FIS Cross Country World Cup, becoming the first American to do so. Jessie's fearlessness and ability to perform under pressure have made her a force to be reckoned with on the international stage.

In February 2024, Jessie will have her first opportunity to race in her home state of Minnesota when the Loppet Foundation, Share Winter Foundation and U.S. Ski & Snowboard host the COOP FIS Cross Country World Cup at Wirth Park in Minneapolis. Jessie is from nearby Afton, Minnesota, and was instrumental in helping to secure the international competition for the state. "I'm excited to give ski fans from around the U.S. a chance to see the action up close for the first time in over 20 years," she said. "I am so proud to represent Minnesota as one of the first American athletes to win Olympic gold in cross country, and now to bring the sport I love to the state I call home."

Beyond her athletic achievements, Jessie is committed to using her platform to make a positive difference in the world, and she has spoken out on issues such as women's involvement in sports, climate change, environmental conservation and mental health. In the 2022-23 season, U.S. Ski & Snowboard proudly launched the *Heroic Initiative*, a movement that celebrates the power of women in skiing and snowboarding while also providing helpful resources and tools to ensure that our women athletes, coaches, staff and others have more opportunities to become leaders in their sport. Athletes like Jessie are a key part of this significant push to bring real, positive change to how sports value female athletes and coaches.

As we look to the future of cross country skiing and women's sports, we look forward to watching Jessie continue to lead and succeed.





**Steven Nyman**  
**Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team**  
2004 - 2023

Three-time World Cup winner and Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team athlete Steven Nyman took the final run of his storied career at Stifel America's Downhill in Aspen, Colorado on March 4, 2023. The 41 year old has been a key member of the Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team since 2004.

A Utah native, Nyman began his career at Sundance Resort before moving to the Park City Ski Team. In 2002, he was chosen to represent the United States at World Junior Championships where he won the slalom and finished second in the combined. He quickly found his way onto the national team and made his official World Cup debut at World Cup Finals in Flachau in 2002, where he finished 15th in the slalom. Since then, his career has included four Olympics, five World Championships, three World Cup wins and a total of 11 World Cup podiums.

"As a kid I dreamt of the Olympics and racing on the World Cup and in World Championship events," said Nyman. "I exceeded those dreams many fold—standing on the top step of World Cup podiums, competing in multiple Olympic Games and World Championship events. There is nothing like expressing yourself on a mountain in such a vulnerable fashion."

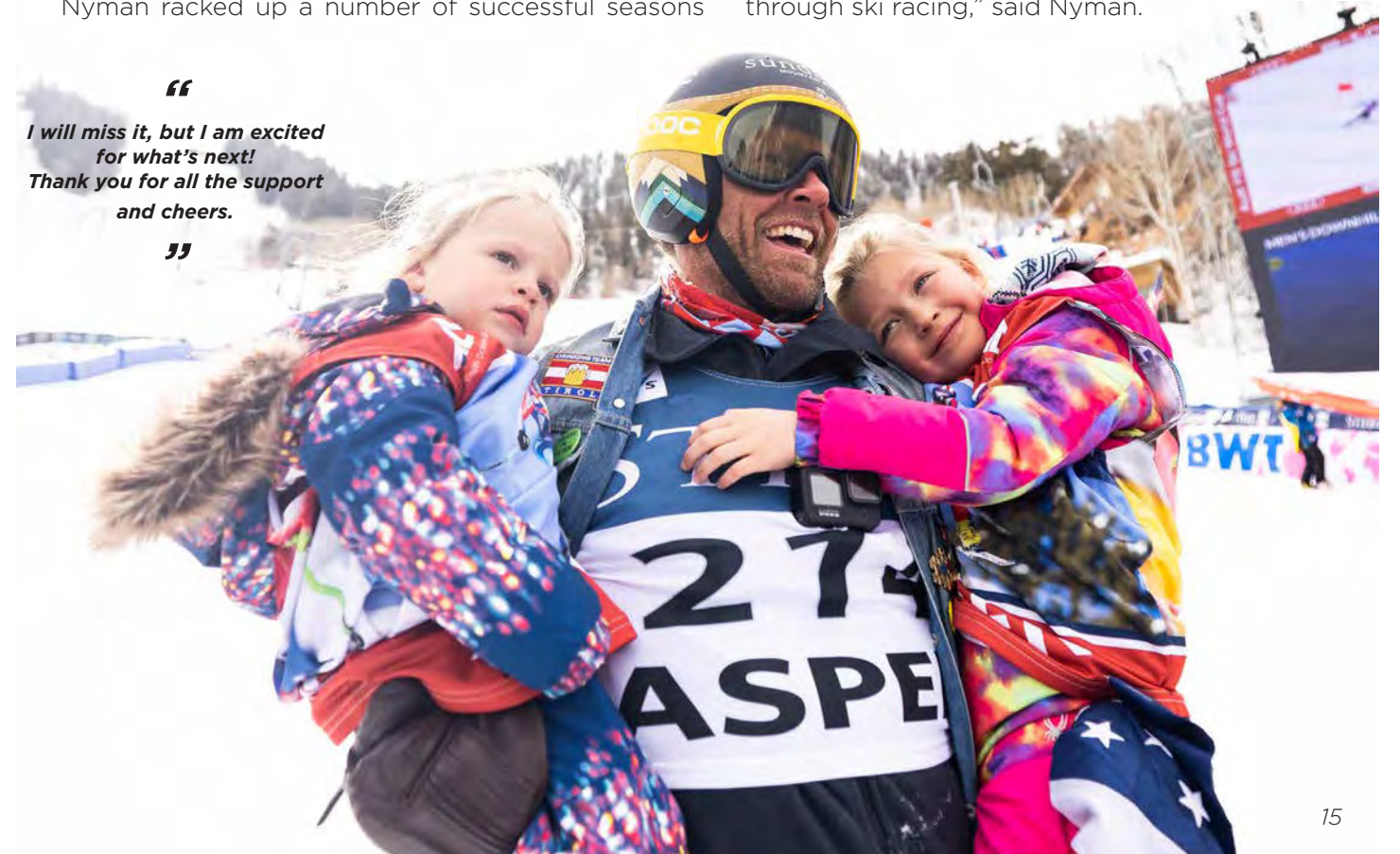
Nyman racked up a number of successful seasons

throughout his career, notably 2015, when he finished sixth in the downhill rank overall and 2016, when he podiumed four races in a row, starting with the PyeongChang Olympic test event in Jeongseon (third) and then Chamonix (second), Kvitfjell (third) and St. Moritz (second). Nyman was on track to race in the 2018 Olympics, but injury kept him out just a few weeks prior to the event. Nyman also earned the title of King of the Saslong, having podiumed a mind-blowing four times on the famed Val Gardena track, including three wins. He also had great success on Beaver Creek's Birds of Prey course, podiuming in front of the home crowd three times.

During Nyman's long tenure, he has taken on a leadership role within the team, inspiring his teammates and the greater U.S. Ski & Snowboard organization, including many athletes in other sports as he rehabbed a number of injuries at the USANA Center of Excellence, including both Achilles tendons, multiple broken legs, hand surgery and blown knees.

"My time is done and I'm ready to move onto the next phase and challenge myself in other ways using the knowledge and experience I have gained through ski racing," said Nyman.

# ATHLETE RETIREMENTS

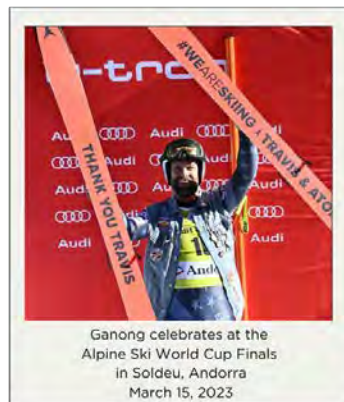




**Travis Ganong**  
**Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team**  
 2006 - 2023

Two-time Olympian and World Championship silver medalist Travis Ganong retired from alpine skiing after 17 years on the Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team. His final race was in Soldeu, Andorra at World Cup Finals. "I achieved my goals by winning World Cups, earning a medal at the World Champs, fighting for podiums at multiple Olympics, and capping it off last month in Kitzbühel with a podium on the Hahnenkamm was an honor," said Ganong.

Ganong's list of accomplishments in the sport is unwavering. He is a two-time Olympian and just missed earning a medal in the downhill in Sochi, finishing fifth. And in the 2015 FIS World Alpine Ski Championships, Ganong rocketed down the downhill at Beaver Creek, Colorado to win a World Championships silver medal in front of the home crowd.

After making his World Cup debut in 2009, Ganong went on to win two World Cups in Santa Caterina, Italy in 2014 and in Garmisch-Partenkirchen, Germany in 2017, and have six podium performances ranging from 2014 to 2023. Most notably, he podiumed this season on the famous Kitzbühel track, securing third place in the downhill—a long-time career goal for the veteran racer.

"It's time to transition from ski racing back to the place it all started: a true love for skiing and experiencing an adventurous life lived outdoors," said Ganong. "I am excited to continue this journey with the partners who have supported me throughout my career." Ganong is also a staunch advocate for the environment, acting as a Protect Our Winters athlete alliance member to lead the charge toward change within the alpine ski industry.

The 34 year old plans to continue celebrating his love for the outdoors and skiing by pursuing more backcountry-centered adventures in his home of Tahoe City, California with his fiancé—and fellow World Cup skier—Marie-Michèle Gagnon of Canada, who has also recently retired.

**Brita Sigourney**  
**Stifel U.S. Freeski Team**  
 2011 - 2023

Olympic bronze medalist and three-time Olympian Brita Sigourney announced in March 2023 that she was officially retiring from professional halfpipe skiing. Born in Monterey, California, Sigourney is one of the sport's legends, inspiring generations of halfpipe athletes that have followed in her footsteps.

Sigourney started skiing when she was two years old, and ski racing at age eight before she found freeskiing. During her 13 years on the team, she battled and overcame multiple injuries to return to the top of the game each time. Her list of career accomplishments is impressive:

- Olympic bronze medal at the 2018 PyeongChang Olympic Winter Games
- Three-time Olympian (Sochi, 2014; PyeongChang, 2018; Beijing, 2022)
- Five World Championships teams (2011, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2023)
- World Championships bronze medal in 2019
- Four World Cup wins (Copper Mountain, 2011; Mammoth Mountain 2012; Copper Mountain, 2013; Mammoth Mountain 2018)
- 13 World Cup podiums
- Five-time X Games participant, the most of any woman skier in history
- Five X Games medals: three silver, two bronze
- First woman to land a 1080 in a complete halfpipe run in the 2012 X Games
- FIS Junior World Ski Champion in 2010





**Mick Dierdorff**  
**U.S. Snowboardcross Team**  
2014 - 2023



After spending more than half his life on the competitive snowboard scene, Mick Dierdorff has decided to step away. The 2018 and 2022 Olympian recently announced his retirement from snowboardcross, ending his career at the Bakuriani 2023 FIS Freestyle Ski, Snowboard and Freeski World Championships in Georgia.

The 31 year old from Steamboat Springs, Colorado has been racing at the FIS level since 2006. He competed in halfpipe and slopestyle before ultimately deciding to specialize in snowboardcross in 2007. He became a consistent presence on the NorAm podium, and was first nominated to the U.S. Snowboard Team in 2014. He broke through and found success on the World Cup circuit a few years later, landing his first podium finish at Cerro Catedral, Argentina in 2017. Dierdorff ultimately added two more World Cup podiums to his resume in 2018 and 2021.

His biggest triumph came in 2019 at the FIS World Championships on home soil in Utah. His years of dedication in the gym and on the race course came together, and he walked away as a double World Champion. Breaking a 14-year streak, Dierdorff became the first American man to win the individual snowboardcross title since Seth Wescott in 2005. Two days later, he did it again, winning gold with teammate Lindsey Jacobellis in the mixed team event.

His career has been, in many ways, a love letter to his hometown of Steamboat Springs. He grew up training and competing with the Steamboat Springs Winter Sports Club, where he will now be returning to coach. Dierdorff will also stay busy planning his upcoming wedding to fiancée Katie, and starting his own contracting business. "I'm excited," said Dierdorff. "Overall it's for sure just a bunch of excitement. It's been so fun...it's been a good career and I'm ready for the next thing."

**Alex Deibold**  
**U.S. Snowboardcross Team**  
2004 - 2023

2014 Olympic bronze medalist Alex Deibold has announced his retirement from competitive snowboardcross. A native Vermonter, 36-year-old Deibold has been snowboarding since the age of four. He attended Stratton Mountain School with fellow teammate Lindsey Jacobellis, and U.S. Snowboard Team halfpipe alums Danny Davis and Louie Vito.

Deibold was first named to the U.S. Snowboard Team in 2004. He made his first FIS World Cup appearance in Furano, Japan in 2007, and spent the last 17 years competing at the highest levels. Along the way, Deibold found himself on the World Cup podium six times, and represented the United States five times at the World Championships. He had a strong 2021-22 season, ultimately earning a spot on the 2022 Beijing Olympic Team. However, his plans were derailed when he suffered a major crash at the Cortina d'Ampezzo World Cup just five days before the Opening Ceremonies, leaving him in the hospital with a head injury and ultimately unable to join his teammates in Beijing.

Outside of the start gate, Deibold has always been known for his passion for the environment and the outdoors. He has served on the U.S. Ski & Snowboard Board of Directors as an athlete representative since 2021 and was an Athlete Role Model at the 2020 Youth Olympic Games. His teammates will miss his advice and friendship, both on and off the race course, but don't expect him to take it easy in retirement. He's chasing new adventures with Protect Our Winters, a non-profit focusing on legislation regarding climate change and looking forward to spending time on the mountain as a mentor to young snowboarders, and as a father.





**Hunter Wonders**  
**Stifel U.S. Cross Country Ski Team**  
2021 - 2023

Hunter Wonders has formally announced his retirement from World Cup ski racing. Wonders grew up in Alaska, along with several other members of the Stifel U.S. Cross Country Ski Team. He has always been a skier, whether that's on the skinny skis or on the wider planks in the Alaskan backcountry. Wonders has been a fixture in the cross country community for years, joining the Alaska Pacific University program as a junior and making the move to the U.S. Team in 2020, making his World Cup debut in January 2021 in the 30k skiathlon in Lahti, Finland. He raced in countless races at various levels including National Championships, Nor-Am Cups, U23 World Ski Championships, Youth Olympic Winter Games, World Cups and World Championships.

On the World Cup level, Wonders was in the top-30 consistently, and had a career-best 11th place in the 2022-2023 Tour de Ski. "Hunter burst on the scene as a junior and contributed a critical leg in the men's silver relay medal at the World Junior Champs in 2018," said the U.S. Cross Country Ski Team Program Director Chris Grover. "As a senior athlete, he steadily climbed the World Cup ranks, securing starts and representing the USA at two World Championships, Oberstdorf and Planica. In the 2022-23 season, Hunter broke through to another level with his first top-20 results, including an 11th place in the 10k classic in Oberstdorf. Hunter has been an incredible teammate and friend and he will be greatly missed in the program, but we are also excited to see where his next adventures take him!"

Off the snow, Wonders is successful in many other ways. Just days ago, he hit another milestone and successfully took his first solo flight in Alaska. Wonders was one of the athletes awarded the Take Flight Textron Aviation U.S. Ski & Snowboard Training Scholarship and is actively working towards his Private Pilot License. When on the road, you could find him studying to become a pilot in-between World Cup races. Even though he is taking a step back from World Cup ski racing, we can be sure we'll continue to see him around the ski trails.

Hailey Swirbul is ready to say goodbye to World Cup ski racing. The 2022 Olympian formally announced her retirement from the World Cup circuit hours after crossing the finish line at the 2022-2023 World Cup Finals in Lahti, Finland.

24-year-old Swirbul, an El Jebel, Colorado native, has been on the U.S. Cross Country Ski Team for years, represented her country at two World Championships and was a member of Team USA in Beijing at the 2022 Olympic Winter Games. She's had a consistent presence on the World Cup throughout the last several years, starting in 64 races, finding the top-10 in four and standing on the 2020 Davos World Cup individual 10k skate podium in third. Now, Hailey is taking a step away from the World Cup circuit and is excited to begin her next chapter.

Hailey started with the Aspen Valley Ski & Snowboard Club until she left for college in 2016, skiing for the University of Alaska Anchorage Ski Team. Finding abundant success on the college circuit, Hailey then trained and competed with the Alaska Pacific University (APU) club team. There, she had breakout results, notably in the 2017 World Junior Championships in Solider Hollow, Utah where she, Katharine Ogden, Julia Kern and Hannah Halvorsen won the USA's first-ever medal at Junior Worlds. In 2019, she was officially called up to the U.S. Cross Country Ski Team.

Outside of skiing, Hailey is active in the community that helped shape her. As a current board member for the Women's Ski Coaches Association, Hailey works day in and day out in helping create a collaborative network to encourage retention of women coaches in the industry. She also has a bachelors degree in civil engineering and this past summer, worked full time as an engineer. "With the end of my World Cup career on the horizon, it is so easy to see how much I appreciate this team," said Swirbul. "It wouldn't be possible for me to have been on the World Cup and chase some big dreams without the support of the U.S. Ski Team, and I will forever be grateful for that."

Since its inception 50 years ago, the Gold Pass Program has grown from a small, grassroots effort to support national ski team athletes into U.S. Ski & Snowboard's largest annual fundraising program. The exceptional growth in the Gold Pass Program is due to the participation and support of the National Ski Areas Association (NSAA) and its member ski areas.



Thanks to the generosity of the NSAA, we sold 517 Gold Passes this season - *the most ever!* That means more than \$5.5 million in funding went to our U.S. Ski & Snowboard athletes from this program.



The Gold Pass is the ultimate snow sports asset that grants access to more than 200 resorts across the country. This unique, fully transferable pass offers you the freedom to ski and ride the best terrain while providing a sustainable source of funding for our athletes. Without the program, U.S. Ski & Snowboard would not be able to adequately fund the team.

- Every dollar raised means more athletes have less out-of-pocket expenses
- More funding allows our athletes to focus solely on their training and performance

However, becoming a Gold Pass member is about more than making a donation - it's about joining our team. Without government funding, our athletes rely on all of us to help them compete on the world stage.



In the 2022-23 season, we launched Gold Pass Snow Days to get out on the slopes with our donors and have some fun. Held the second Wednesday of each month at various resorts, these get-togethers are a big success and we look forward to continuing the events next season!

The Champions Club Program began in 2002 at the Olympic Winter Games in Salt Lake City, Utah. Since then, the program has grown to become a pillar of the Foundation's annual fundraising plan, raising tens of millions of dollars in direct-to-athlete funding since inception. Champions Club supporters have spectacular experiences at our key sports events, which we have held in the United States, Europe and Asia. Trips are all-inclusive with VIP accommodations that include fine dining, exceptional

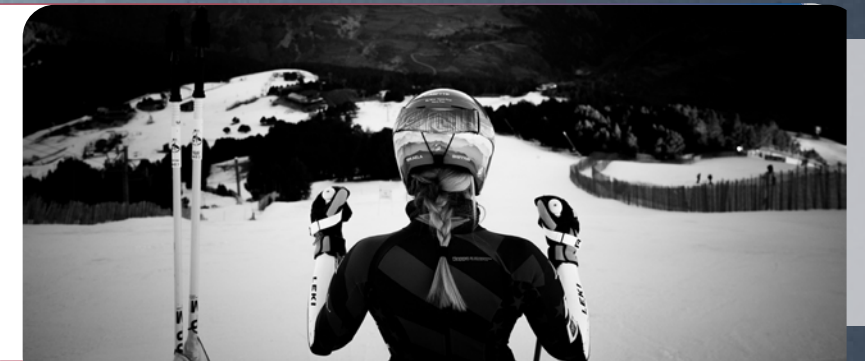

## JEFF SHIFFRIN ATHLETE RESILIENCY FUND

est. 2020



In the world of snow sports, Mikaela Shiffrin is a household name. At 28 years old, she is now the greatest alpine skier of all time with two Olympic gold medals, 88 World Cup wins and five Overall Crystal Globe titles. With discipline and determination, she has navigated a path to sports immortality that was paved with great successes and also many challenges.

On February 2, 2020, following a tragic accident at her family's home, her beloved father, Jeff Shiffrin, passed away with his family at his side. The year that followed was one of unprecedented challenges as the world grappled with the pandemic. While the Shiffrin family was in the midst of their own grief and shock, they recognized that everyone was suffering in some way, and the national team athletes were no exception. Thanks to the generosity of several caring donors in collaboration with the Shiffrin family, the Jeff Shiffrin Athlete Resiliency Fund was formed. It enabled U.S. Ski & Snowboard to respond quickly and effectively to the needs of all our athletes across all sport disciplines by stabilizing our funding.

**For the last two seasons, the purpose of the Jeff Shiffrin Athlete Resiliency Fund has been to provide need-based, direct-to-athlete stipends that help support all aspects of our athletes' sports careers.**

Jeff's life and legacy are honored through this Fund by incorporating what he valued in athletes - hard work, grit and determination - into the application process. Current A-D/Pro-Rookie team athletes must submit applications providing insight into what was important to him, specifically their demonstrated ability to break through to the next elite level of their sport and their commitment to excellence in athletic performance.

Congratulations to the 54 Jeff Shiffrin Athlete Resiliency Fund award winners of the 2022-23 season! These athletes have demonstrated extraordinary commitment to their sport, continuing to push themselves to even greater levels of achievement.

After our incredible success in direct marketing last year (the 2021-22 season was our most successful year ever!) we are still going strong but experiencing some challenges in a post-Olympic year. A tougher and more uncertain economic climate has affected donations in the fundraising sector. Like most other non-profits and National Governing Bodies (NGBs), we noted decline in direct marketing gifts, with average gross revenue down 20-25% across the sector.

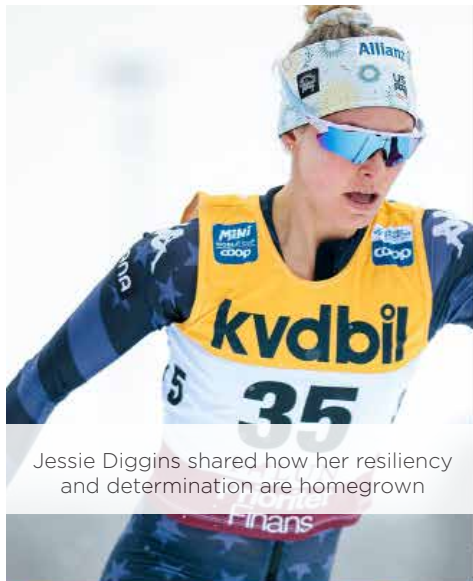
While fundraising declined slightly compared to the previous season, there was overall growth in key areas. In the 2022-23 season we had:

- More than 100 new donors
- 46 Podium Club members and growing! And a goal of 100+ members in two years
- The largest direct mail donation in our history - \$20,000!

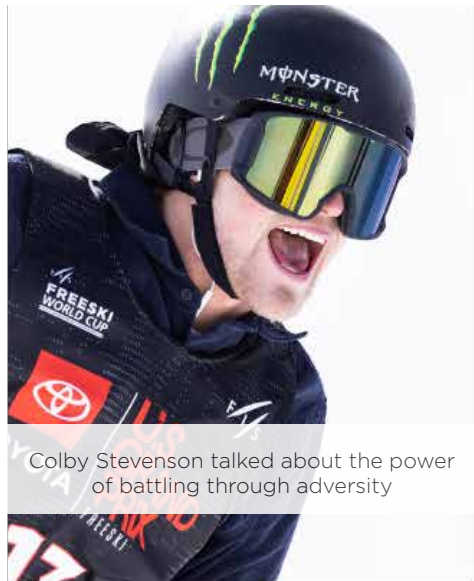

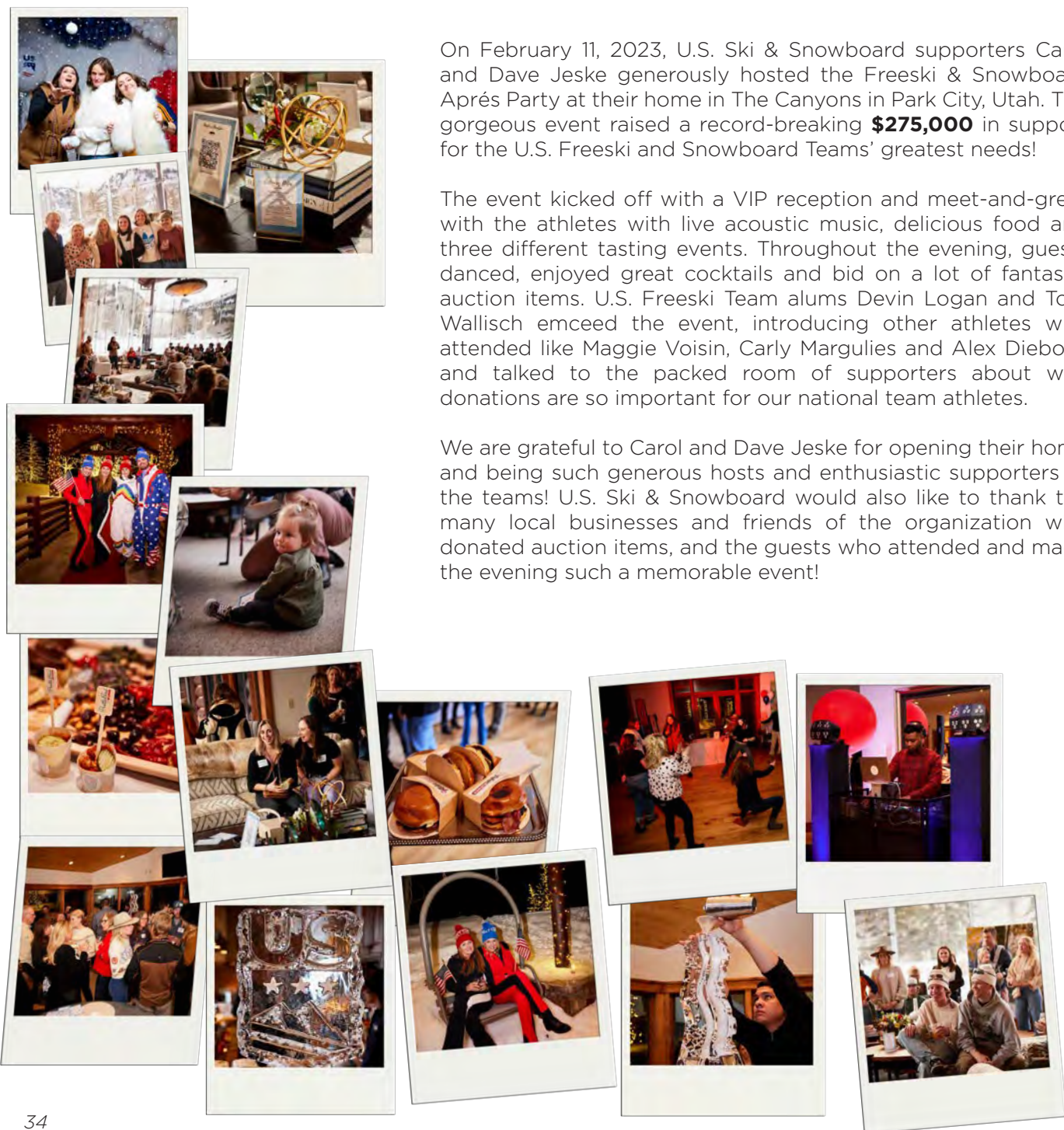
## FREESKI & SNOWBOARD APRÉS PARTY

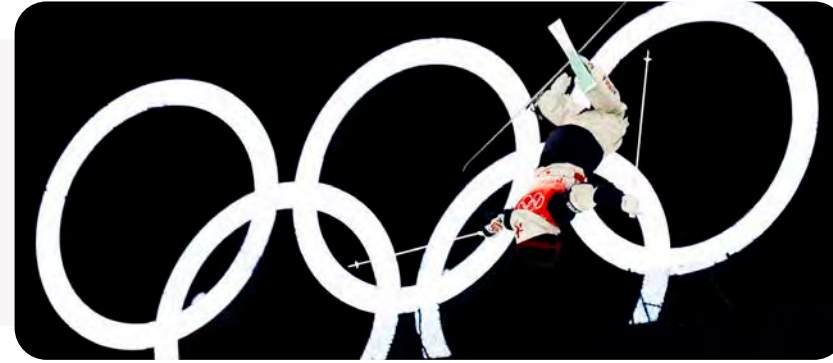

Since its inception in 2017, the Principal Giving Program has become an integral part of the Foundation's fundraising efforts. Principal gifts are transformational for the organization because they cannot be reduced or reallocated, even in the event of a budget shortfall.

As a non-profit, the ability to guarantee portions of our annual budget is a game-changer for us and for our athletic programming. ## STIFEL U.S. CROSS COUNTRY SKI TEAM



The Stifel U.S. Cross Country Ski Team is a great example of the power of philanthropy to impact performance. Since 2019, the team has received significant investment from generous and enthusiastic supporters who want to make a real difference in our athletes' lives. Their gifts have supported the team's training, travel, coaching, sports medicine and high performance and nutritional needs, with incredible results. The women's and men's teams are breaking new ground for the United States in cross country skiing. Stable funding for the team helps the athletes focus solely on their performance without worrying about whether their training camps or competitions starts will be cut due to budget shortfalls.

### 2022-2023 season highlights:

- Jessie Diggins won World Ski Championships (WSC) gold in the 10 km skate in Planica, Slovenia - this is the first individual WSC gold medal for the United States in history!
- Jessie Diggins and Julia Kern won bronze in the WSC freestyle team sprint in Planica, Slovenia
- Rosie Brennan was fifth in the 30 km classic at the Planica World Champs
- Jessie Diggins finished second in the Overall World Cup and 2nd in the Distance World Cup
- Rosie Brennan finished 4th in the overall World Cup and sixth in the distance World Cup
- This is the first time the United States has had two women in the top-five in the overall World Cup
- Ben Ogden was eighth in the overall World Cup
- Julia Kern finished seventh in the sprint World Cup
- 11 World Cup podiums for the 2022-23 season
- First World Cup podium for Sophia Laukli - third in the Tour de Ski final climb
- Ben Ogden won the U23 season World Cup standings - the first time an American athlete has won this category!
- The U.S. men's team moved from ninth to sixth in the Nation's Cup this season and will have an additional World Cup quota spot next season as a result

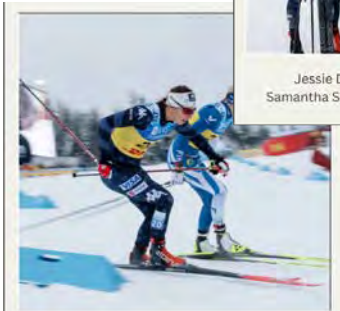

## STIFEL U.S. FREESTYLE SKI TEAM



The cross country athletes aren't the only ones who have benefitted from much-needed philanthropic investment. The Stifel U.S. Freestyle Moguls Ski Team has also received funding in the last two seasons at the elite and developmental level, and the team's performance and future prospects are even stronger as a result. The initial round of funding in 2021 created the Development Team, which allowed U.S. Ski & Snowboard to train athletes in the pipeline faster and with more efficiency. Athletes like Cole McDonald and Elizabeth Lemley went from the D Team to the A Team in one season, and their performance steadily progressed through the 2022-23 season resulting in World Cup podiums. We also had fantastic results this season from team veterans like Jaelin Kauf, Olivia Giaccio, Nick Page and Hannah Soar.

Multi-year investments in the team made it possible to hire more coaching staff and enhanced the level of training our athletes receive. Former U.S. Olympic moguls athlete Bryon Wilson, and Josh Kober, a renowned coach who previously worked with the British Columbia Provincial Team, joined our staff last season and they are already making a big impact. In the 2023-24 season, they will continue to elevate the team's overall performance, building on the results of this season.

## STIFEL U.S. ALPINE SKI TEAM



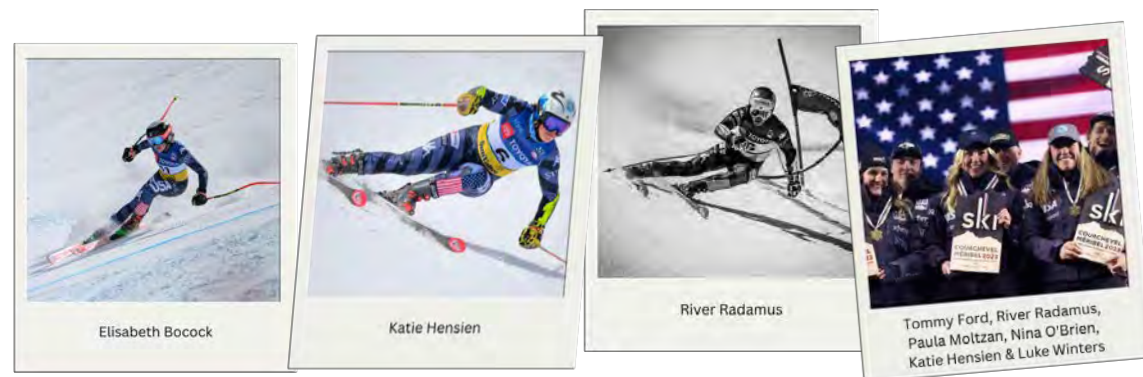
Accelerating the Stifel U.S. Alpine Ski Team's performance on all levels is another priority initiative for U.S. Ski & Snowboard. This winning-at-every-level ("WELL") approach is designed to tackle the biggest challenges we face in the sport, specifically a lack of resources to fully manage and sustain the national system at the NorAm, Europa and World Cup levels. The WELL program has built out the coaching and tech staff to properly support each level of the alpine team, and created a fully managed and funded NorAm Team. The program has also funded more athlete starts at the NorAm, Europa and World Cup levels.

The WELL program represents the natural evolution of years of work in U.S. alpine skiing to shift from a top-down, elite-level approach to funding and training to a holistic approach that emphasizes support for the athlete development pipeline. More alpine athletes need to be meeting specific performance markers:

- Achieving top-10 and podium results at the NorAm level
- Being fully prepared to medal at the World Junior Championships
- Moving up the development pipeline to the elite levels by achieving objective qualifications at an accelerated rate

Since U.S. athletes do not receive any government funding, they have a competitive disadvantage against dominant European nations that can simply over-fund their teams in critical areas like coaching, training and performance. Specifically, the WELL program focuses on the following needs:

- More coaches at the NorAm and Europa Cup levels
- More athlete competition starts at NorAm and Europa Cup events
- More ski technicians at all levels (speed and tech)
- Additional physical therapists and athletic training coordinators for the Development Team, Europa Cup and World Cup levels
- Funding for additional on-snow training days for the speed and tech teams
- Sport psychology support staff
- Enhanced Return-To-Performance support for athletes rehabilitating from injury
- Travel support for additional athletes and new staff



## BOB BEATTIE ATHLETE TRAVEL FUND



**U.S. Ski & Snowboard is thrilled to announce that we reached our \$20 million fundraising goal for the Bob Beattie Athlete Travel Fund!** This endowed fund supports the travel expenses for our A, B, C and Pro Team athletes, in perpetuity. Prior to the inception of the Beattie Fund, athletes named to the national team would receive a letter congratulating them on making the team that included a significant bill to cover their travel costs. The U.S. Ski & Snowboard Foundation is striving to eliminate that issue permanently, and endowing the Beattie Fund is a big step towards achieving that goal.

We launched our fundraising efforts for the Bob Beattie Athlete Travel Fund in 2017 as part of the larger Marolt Athlete Endowment campaign. Now fully endowed, the Fund will provide nearly \$1 million annually for our athletes' travel expenses.

### Who was Bob Beattie?

Bob Beattie was an icon of the sport of alpine ski racing and one of its most passionate pioneers. He was a driving force for ski racing his entire life, counted among the sport's leaders who built it into one of the pillar events of the Olympic Winter Games. He was the founding coach of the U.S. Ski Team and one of the creators of the FIS Alpine Ski World Cup. Fierce and outspoken, Bob continued to advocate for the sport he loved long after his retirement from coaching, promoting and fundraising for the team on an unprecedented scale. He felt deeply that all national team athletes should have their expenses covered, especially their travel costs.

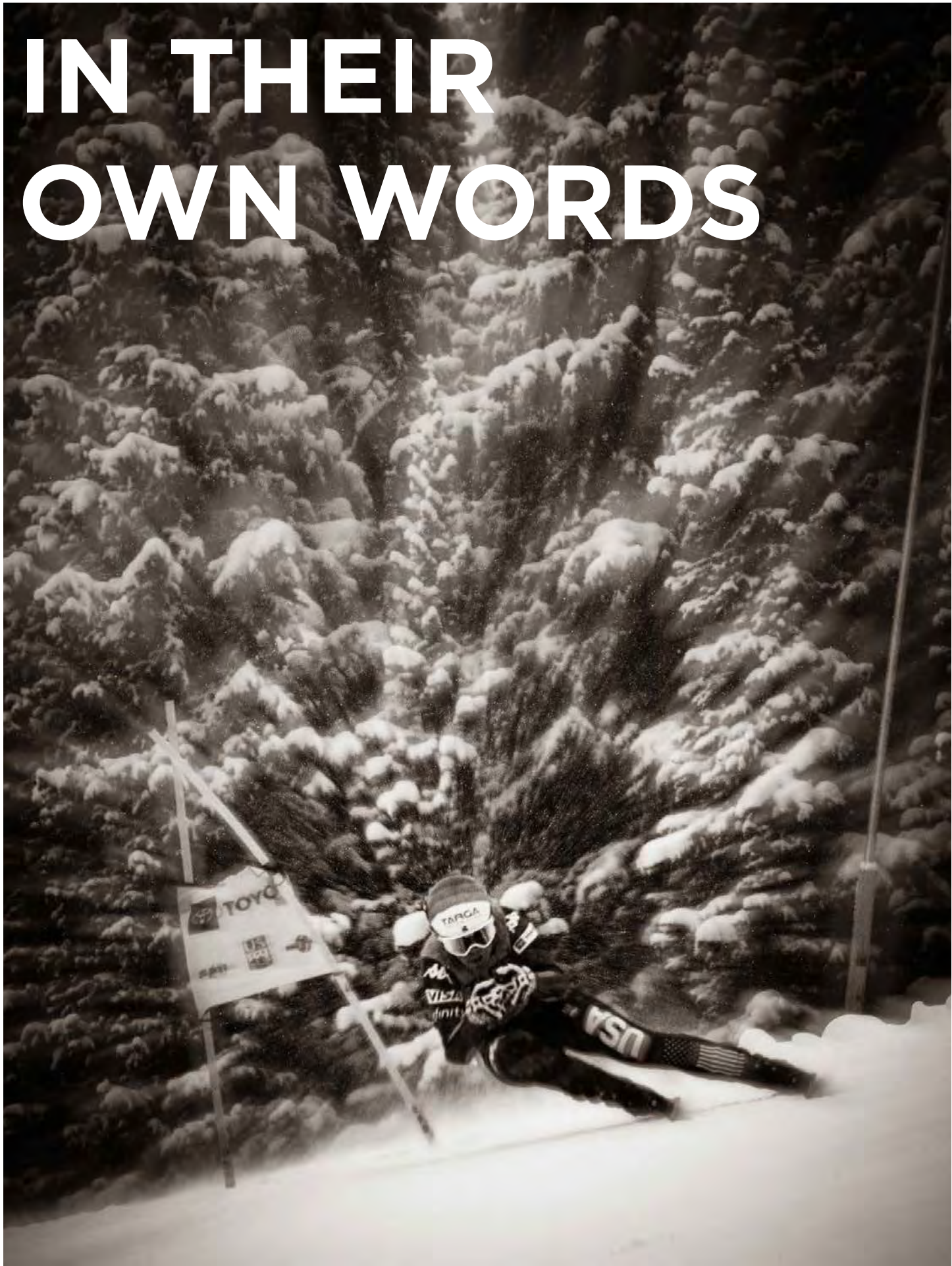
Bob was one of the most decorated officials in skiing's history, receiving numerous honors including the U.S. Ski Association's Julius Blegen Award (1964) and he was inducted into the U.S. Ski & Snowboard Hall of Fame (1984). He passed away in April of 2018 at the age of 84.

**J. Richard Steadman, M.D.**  
**Orthopedics Pioneer**  
1937 - 2023



Dr. J. Richard Steadman, “Steady” to his friends, was a world-renowned sports medicine surgeon and physician, who passed away on January 20, 2023 at the age of 85. Dr. Steadman was the founder and chairman emeritus of the eponymous Steadman Clinic in Vail, Colorado, as well as the founder and co-chairman of Steadman Philippon Research Institute, which is a world leader in orthopedic research and education. A renowned innovator and mentor in the field of orthopaedic sports medicine, Dr. Steadman is internationally known for the development of several advanced surgical procedures for the knee. He treated numerous professional athletes across various sports and was sought out by some of the world’s best-known athletes and public figures for treatment. His ability to return high-level athletes with knee injuries to medal winning victories following surgery and rehab with him made him an iconic figure in sports medicine.

Dr. Steadman treated well over 22,000 patients during his 40-year career in Tahoe and Vail, which included returning more than 130 professional athletes to major athletic achievements following potentially career ending injuries. In addition to members of the U.S. Ski & Snowboard Team, the list includes such legendary athletes as tennis greats Martina Navratilova, Monica Seles and Billie Jean King, NFL Hall of Famers Dan Marino and Bruce Smith, musicians Judy Collins and Rod Stewart and global soccer sensations Cristiano Ronaldo and Lothar Matthaeus. Dr. Steadman became a consultant to the Denver Broncos and Colorado Rockies while serving as U.S. Alpine Chief Physician at nine consecutive Olympic Winter Games from 1976 through 2006.

Dr. Steadman founded and championed U.S. Ski & Snowboard’s Sports Medicine program, chairing U.S. Ski & Snowboard’s Medical Committee and working alongside the first medical director Melinda Roalstad, MS, PAC. “Dr. Steadman affected every aspect of U.S. Ski & Snowboard throughout his career—from his world-renowned medical care to forging our medical program and chairing our medical committee, to helping formulate our foundational sports medicine policies and procedures,” said U.S. Ski & Snowboard Director of High Performance Gillian Bower. “His vision of athlete health and wellbeing will continue to have broad impact on both the athletes and our Sports Medicine Department. His generosity with his talents, time and passion for our sports will live on within our organization in perpetuity.”





**Kyle Smaine**  
Freestyle Athlete  
1991 - 2023

Beloved member of the freeski community Kyle Smaine passed away on January 29, 2023 in an avalanche in Japan. A halfpipe gold medalist in the 2015 FIS World Ski Championships, Smaine was a respected professional skier who loved nothing more than being outdoors.

A native of South Lake Tahoe, California, Smaine had multiple banner results at the X Games, Toyota U.S. Grand Prix and just missed making the Olympic Winter Games in PyeongChang.

Smaine and his wife, Jenna Dramise, married in a private ceremony in November 2022 with a handful of friends and family in attendance. The couple was planning a destination wedding in New Zealand at the end of 2023.

During the 2023 Toyota U.S. Grand Prix at Mammoth Mountain in February, hundreds of current and former athletes, family and friends descended the halfpipe together in a beautiful tribute to Smaine.



**Emmett Harold Hall, Jr.**  
Freestyle Athlete  
1958 - 2023

Emmett Hall passed away on February 23, 2023 in Reno, Nevada at the age of 65. Emmett was a world-ranked aerial skier and member of the U.S. Freestyle Ski Team in 1980, competing in aeriels, moguls and ballet skiing. He later worked at and ran Lake Tahoe Ski Etude, a ski academy in Incline Village, training the next generation of athletes. Emmett was born in Redding, California, on January 4, 1958. He attended Shasta High School in Redding, California, and Sierra Nevada College in Incline Village, Nevada. He passionately worked in the financial services business as a financial advisor since 1988. He loved nothing more than getting on his spin bike to start the day while turning on the financial news to see the overnight market action. Emmett spent every day speaking with his clients and closest friends about the economy. He watched CNBC every morning until the end.

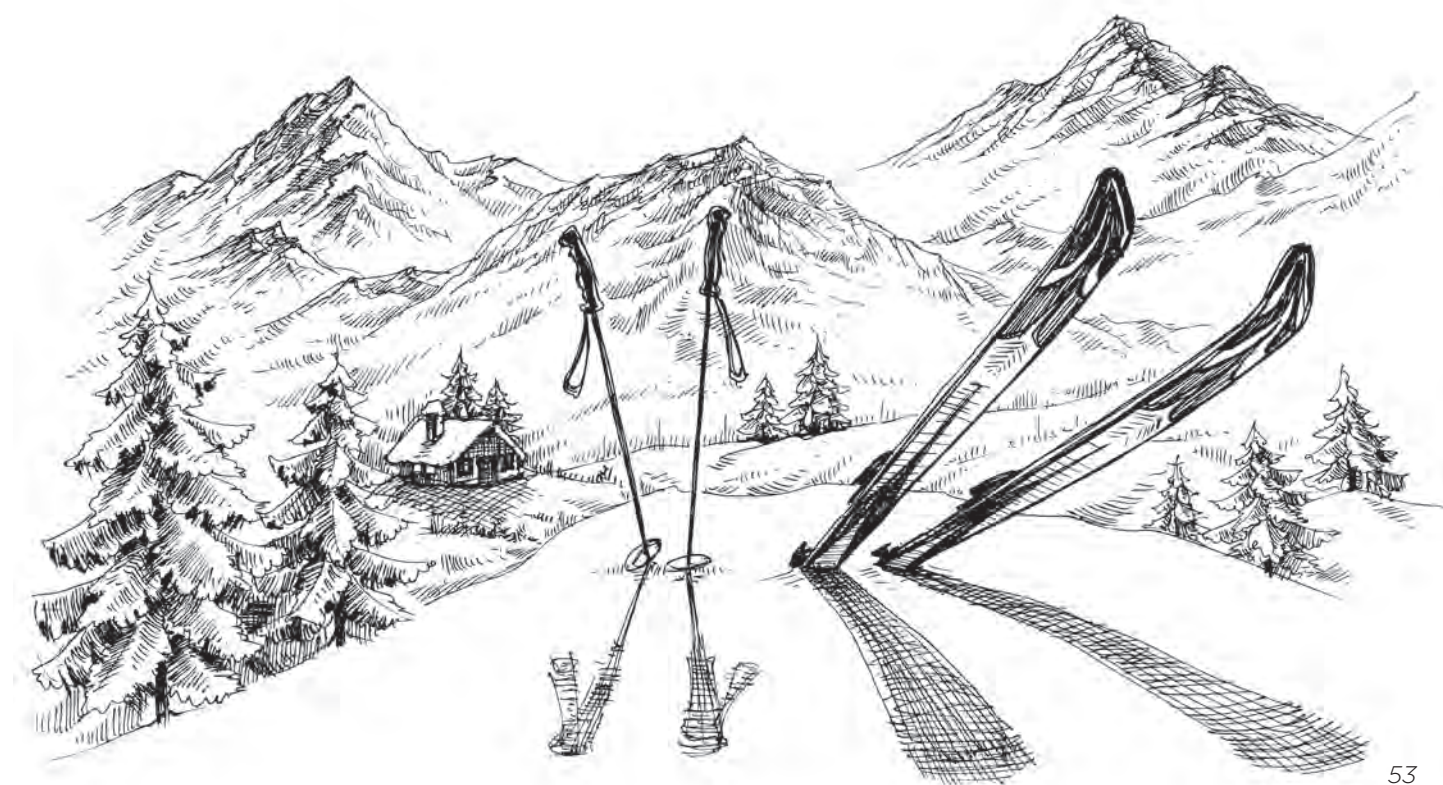
Beyond work, Emmett spent as much time as he could outside—especially on his road bike, often riding 40+ miles at a time around Northern Nevada, and in his favorite places such as Palm Springs and California wine country. He served on the Board of Trustees of Sierra Nevada College for many years as well as the board of the Procrastinating Pedalers of Reno-Tahoe. It was in Tahoe that he met his wife, Heather, on a backpacking trip. They were married 40 years. Together, they had two daughters, Gabrielle and Madeleine. Emmett trained each of them for competitive trampoline and ski racing, putting his heart and soul into their success. He loved dancing and listening to live music on the weekends, wearing his signature black button-down shirt and sunglasses—a bold red wine in his hand. In addition to his wife and daughters, Emmett is survived by his sister, Jenni Hall, his son-in-law Jared Barnett and daughter-in-law Lauren Fetty, and the many friends who loved him.



**Jeremy Nobis**  
Alpine Athlete  
1970 - 2023

Former U.S. Alpine Ski Team athlete and Olympian Jeremy Nobis passed away on April 19, 2023 in Cedar City, Utah at the age of 52. Nobis was a storied ski racer. He attended Vermont’s Green Mountain Valley School and made the U.S. Alpine Ski Team in the late 1980s. He won two World Junior Championships at 1988 and 1989, before competing in tech events on the World Cup circuit through 1995. He attended the 1994 Olympic Winter Games, racing in the giant slalom and slalom and finished ninth in the GS.

Post-ski racing, Nobis switched to big mountain skiing, where he became known for skiing lines down some of the steepest runs around the world and was dubbed “The Icon.” He was featured in a number of Warren Miller, Teton Gravity Research and Matchstick Productions movies throughout his career. He also had a pro model ski designed by Dynastar and helped design new skis for the then burgeoning freeskiing culture. He is the brother of Shannon Nobis, who also skied for the U.S. Alpine Ski Team at the 1994 Olympic Winter Games.

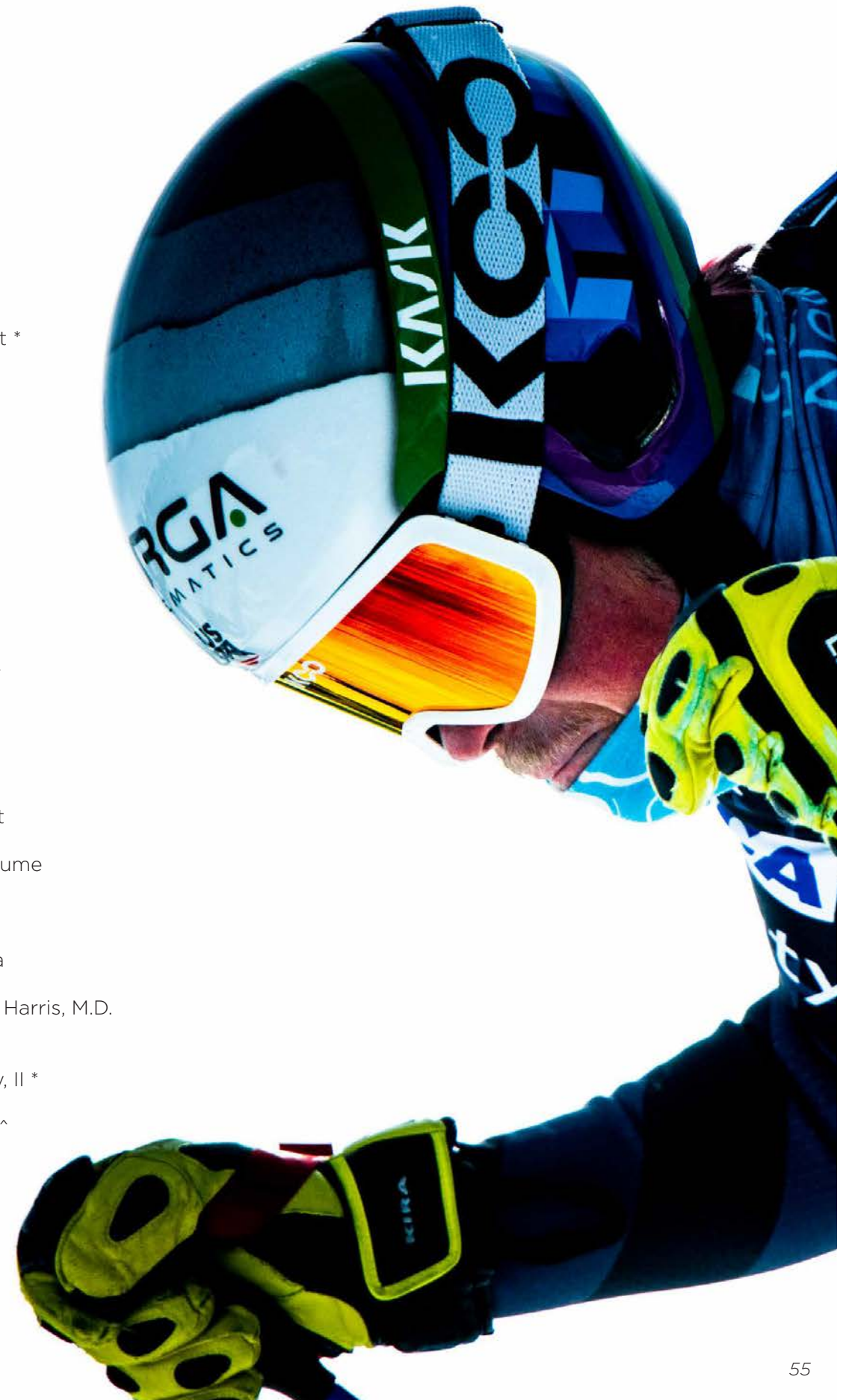

Vice President, Philanthropic Giving

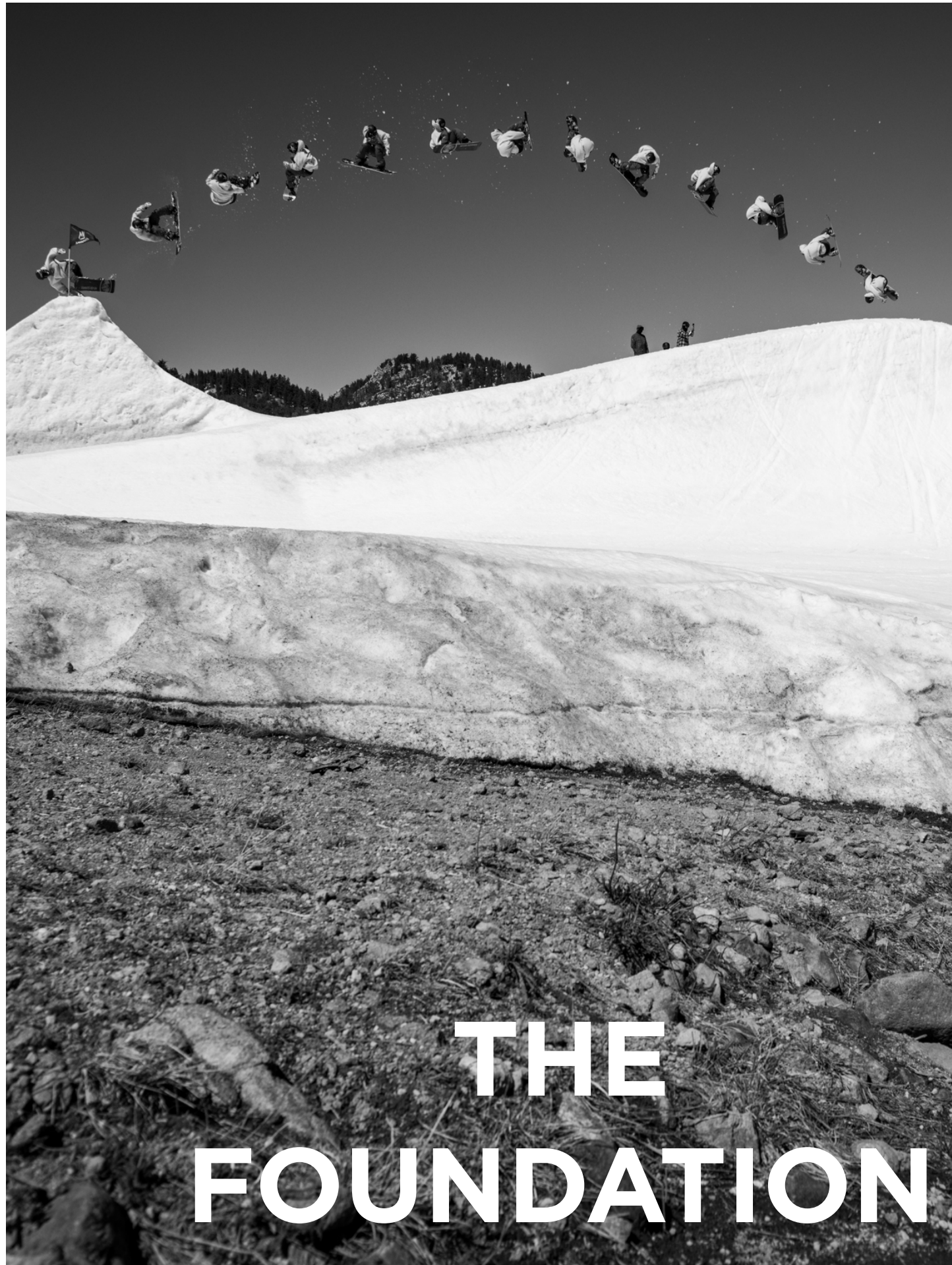

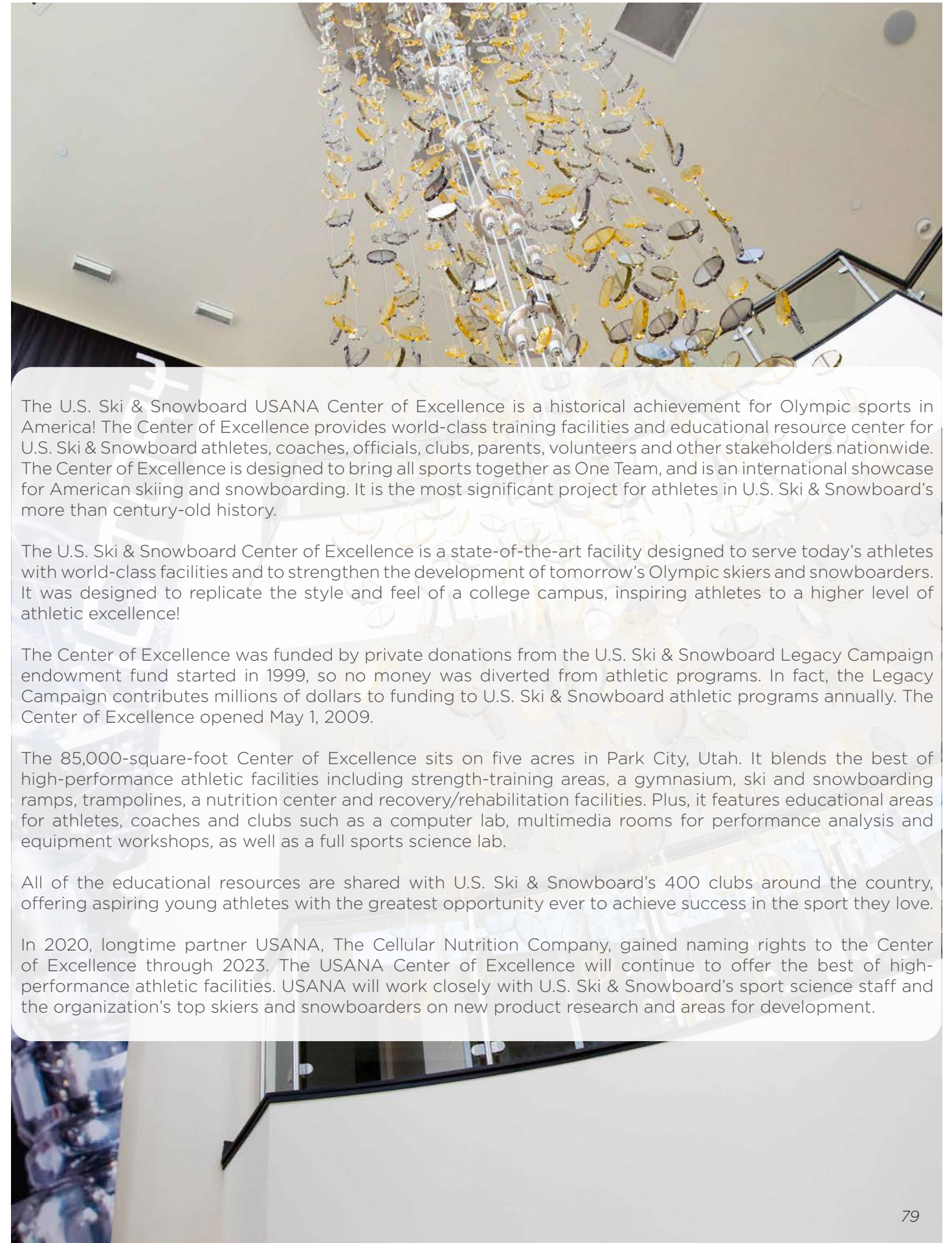

# USANA CENTER OF EXCELLENCE



The U.S. Ski & Snowboard USANA Center of Excellence is a historical achievement for Olympic sports in America! The Center of Excellence provides world-class training facilities and educational resource center for U.S. Ski & Snowboard athletes, coaches, officials, clubs, parents, volunteers and other stakeholders nationwide. The Center of Excellence is designed to bring all sports together as One Team, and is an international showcase for American skiing and snowboarding. It is the most significant project for athletes in U.S. Ski & Snowboard's more than century-old history.

The U.S. Ski & Snowboard Center of Excellence is a state-of-the-art facility designed to serve today's athletes with world-class facilities and to strengthen the development of tomorrow's Olympic skiers and snowboarders. It was designed to replicate the style and feel of a college campus, inspiring athletes to a higher level of athletic excellence!

The Center of Excellence was funded by private donations from the U.S. Ski & Snowboard Legacy Campaign endowment fund started in 1999, so no money was diverted from athletic programs. In fact, the Legacy Campaign contributes millions of dollars to funding to U.S. Ski & Snowboard athletic programs annually. The Center of Excellence opened May 1, 2009.

The 85,000-square-foot Center of Excellence sits on five acres in Park City, Utah. It blends the best of high-performance athletic facilities including strength-training areas, a gymnasium, ski and snowboarding ramps, trampolines, a nutrition center and recovery/rehabilitation facilities. Plus, it features educational areas for athletes, coaches and clubs such as a computer lab, multimedia rooms for performance analysis and equipment workshops, as well as a full sports science lab.

All of the educational resources are shared with U.S. Ski & Snowboard's 400 clubs around the country, offering aspiring young athletes with the greatest opportunity ever to achieve success in the sport they love.

In 2020, longtime partner USANA, The Cellular Nutrition Company, gained naming rights to the Center of Excellence through 2023. The USANA Center of Excellence will continue to offer the best of high-performance athletic facilities. USANA will work closely with U.S. Ski & Snowboard's sport science staff and the organization's top skiers and snowboarders on new product research and areas for development.
